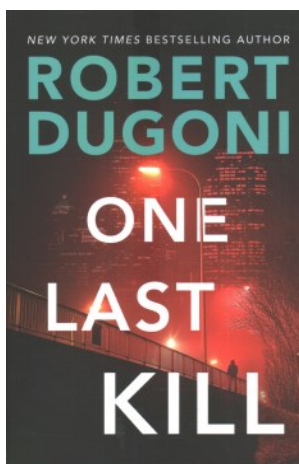

by Robert Dugoni

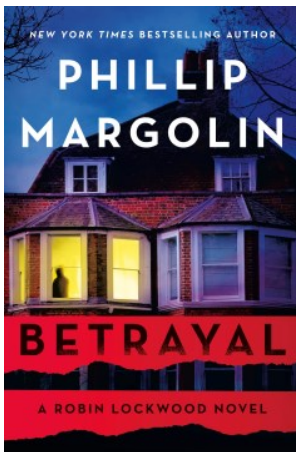

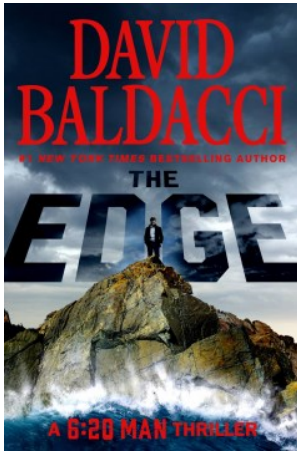


### *Inheritance / : The Lost Bride Trilogy, Book 1*

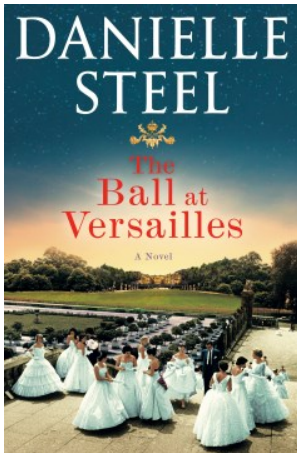




### *The Edge - November 14*

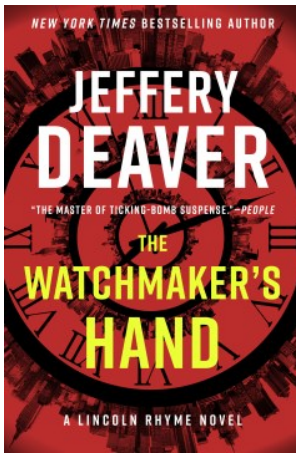

by Jeffery Deaver

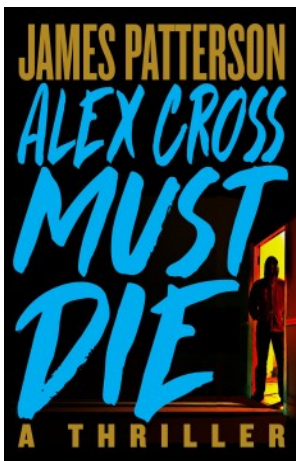
