by Dreda Say Mitchell

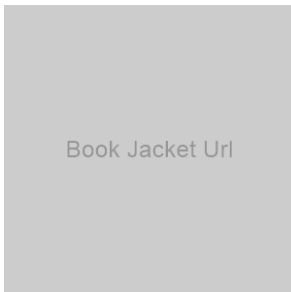
