

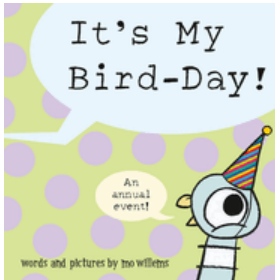

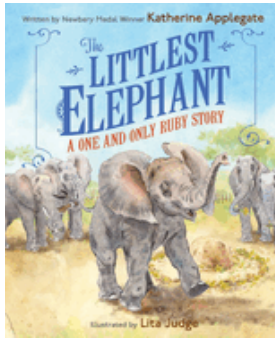

by Katherine Applegate

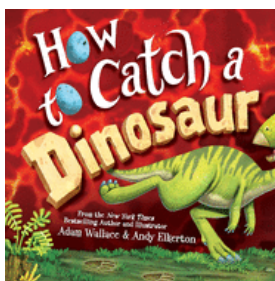

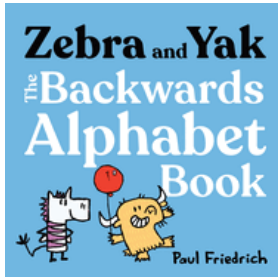
Determined to win a new bicycle at the upcoming Science Fair, a boy enlists his friends to help capture a living dinosaur in their own neighborhood.

by Linda Bailey

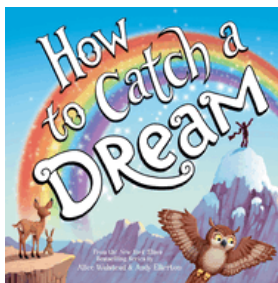

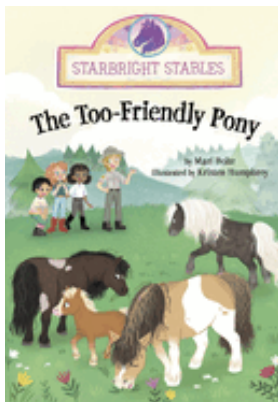
